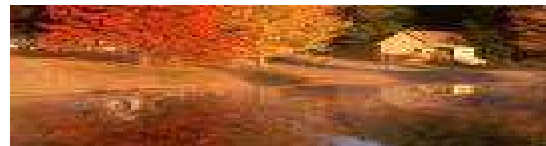
A NOTE FROM OUR PRESIDENT

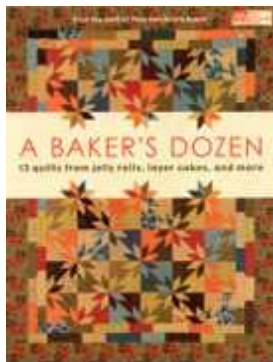
